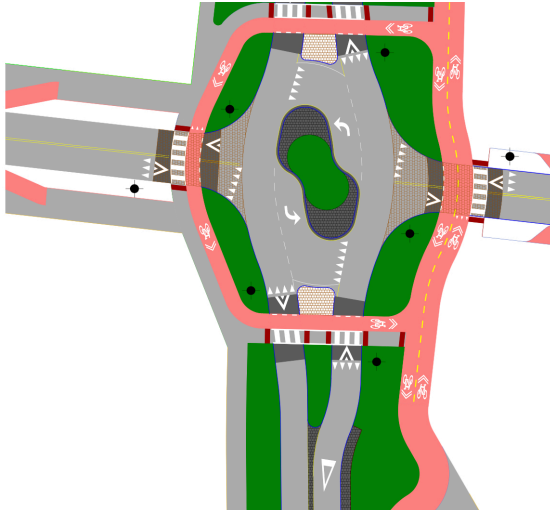


Dutch Inspired Intersection Test
